Dear Shri. Oommen,

As you are aware, in our capacity as Commissioners of the Supreme Court in CWP 196/2001, PUCL v. UOI and others, we monitor the implementation of the food and employment related schemes in the country which fall under the purview of the case including the ICDS, MDMS, NREGA, NOAPS, TPDS, NMBS /JSY and NFBS.

As you would already know, the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed an order on 27th January, 2010 (Annexure A) directing all state governments to respond to our letter to the Supreme Court dated 25th January, 2010 (Annexure B) on the issue of providing night shelters, antyodaya cards and community kitchens for homeless people in urban areas and residential hostels for street children.


This order also states that this matter will be taken up by the Supreme Court on February 9th. In this regard, for our follow-up report to the Supreme Court we are collecting information provisioning of shelters and access to food to homeless people in all the states in the country including yours. **We request you to kindly send us the data before 5th February so that we are able to submit the report on time. We hope that you send the data on time so that we are able to present an accurate picture in the Supreme Court.**

- **Number of temporary shelters for the homeless**
- **Number of permanent shelters for the homeless**
- **Number of community kitchens providing subsidised food for the homeless**
- **Number of Antyodaya cards distributed to the homeless**
