Dear,

As you are aware, in our capacity as Commissioners of the Supreme Court in the case PUCL v. UoI and Others (CWP 196/ 2001), we monitor the implementation of the food and work related schemes in the country and regularly submit reports to the Supreme Court.

We have analysed the data received from the *Ministry of Women and Child Development*, Government of India on the status of the operationalisation of the Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) for the those that have been sanctioned by Government of India till 31.3.2010.

For the State of XXX, we find that as many as YYY number of sanctioned AWCs have still not been operationalised. The Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) is a major national programme that addresses the needs of children under six years. Since 2001, the Supreme Court has passed numerous orders on universalizing the ICDS with quality. The coverage figures for your state reflect the status of universalisation to be far from universal.

In this context, we would like to know the reason of [number] of Anganwadis are not been made operational in [state]. Do please also send us district-wise information of number of Anganwadi Centres, Mini Anganwadi Centres has been sanctioned / operational by March 2010. Kindly share the information on the numbers of anganwadis has been operational in SC/ST hamlets as well. We would request that the requisite information be sent to us in following format.
